

MATH 9400 Approval Form (Undergraduate Independent Study)

The following rules apply to any undergraduate student interested in taking a mathematics independent study for credit.

1. The student's GPA in mathematics courses must be at least 3.3. Any exceptions to this rule must be approved by the chair of the department.
2. At most 8 credit-hours of independent study may be used to fulfill the requirements of the major.
3. Agreement from a regular faculty member and approval from the chair of the department are required before a student may register for an independent study.
4. The student and faculty member in question must agree on the material to be covered, the schedule, and the grading procedures in advance of seeking approval from the chair.

After obtaining the relevant signatures, this form should be taken to the mathematics program assistant (in ENG 274) to receive a permission number.
